1. **Roses** - one bloom.
2. **Roses** - 1 stem Cluster AV.
3. **Sweet Peas** - one vase maximum 9 stems - AVV
4. **Annuals** - one vase mixed kinds - maximum 7 stems.
5. **A Favourite Flower from my Garden** - 1 Stem or Flower.
6. **Hydrangeas** - 3 stems - AVV.
7. **Clematis Blooms** – 3 in a dish of water – AVV.
8. **Herbaceous Perennials** - one vase mixed kinds, maximum 10 stems.
9. **Foliage** - one vase – max 7 stems.
10. **Flowering Shrubs** – one vase, 5 stems, AVV.
11. **Gladioli** - one vase -1spike, AVV.
12. **Grasses** - one vase, fresh cut – max 7 stems, AVV.
13. **Hostas** - 3 leaves, AVV.
14. **Dahlias** - one container, 3 large, AVV, larger than 17cm (6.75").
15. **Dahlias** - one container, 3 small, AVV, maximum 17cm (6.75").
16. **Pelargonium or Geranium** – one pot, AVV, maximum 23cm (9") diameter.
17. **One Pot Fuchsia** – maximum pot diameter 23cm (9").
18. **One Pot Orchid** – AVV, maximum pot diameter 23cm (9").
19. **One Flowering Pot Plant** - other than classes 20 to 22, maximum pot diameter 23cm (9").
20. **Foliage Pot Plant** – maximum pot diameter 23cm (9").
21. **One Cactus Plant** - maximum pot diameter 23cm (9").
22. **One Succulent Plant** - maximum pot diameter 23cm (9").
23. **Alpine(s)** - in a Pot or Pan of max diameter 23cm (9").
24. **Any Cut Flower** - one vase, one kind of any flower not listed above, maximum 7 stems.
